**Instead of “May our mouths be filled...”  
we sing *three* times:**  
Chris is risen from the dead conquering death by death  
and to those in the graves bestowing life.

**Instead of “Blessed be the name of the Lord...”  
we sing *three* times:**  
Chris is risen from the dead conquering death by death and to  
those in the graves bestowing life.

**At the dismissal, instead of “Glory be to the Father... and  
ever. Amen.” we sing:**  
Chris is risen from the dead conquering death by death  
and to those in the graves bestowing life.

**After the final Amen, the priest, with cross raised on high,  
exclaims “Christ is risen” thrice and we respond “Indeed, He  
is risen” each time. Then, the Troparion “Christ is risen” is  
sung as at the beginning of the Liturgy, but with the addition:**

And to us he has granted life eternal;/  
we worship His third-day resurrection.
